



# Meet my Most Inspirational Friend, Rachel



I first met Rachel over 38 years ago when we both lived in Bondi. We became instant friends.

Rachel has certainly faced more than her fair share of hardships.

Just over eighteen years ago, she lost both her legs in a train accident at Sydney's Central Station. Ten years later, she was declared legally blind after losing sight in her left eye. She had already lost sight in her right eye years earlier

due to a detached retina.

Yet despite these awful misfortunes, she refuses to give up on life.

Today, she walks on two prosthetic limbs and the aid of a walker, and boasts a "full calendar" of social activities.

"Life is a gift," said the single mother who lives in Bondi. "It's not what happens to you — it's how you deal with it that matters. You can sit and feel sorry for yourself, or you can deal with what you've got and do your best. I just enjoy being alive."
